

YORK AREA CZECH-SLOVAK QUEEN

RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. Contestant must be a resident of the State of Nebraska.
2. Contestant must be single. She must never have been married nor ever have been pregnant.
3. Contestant must be a high school graduate or attending high school at the time of competition.
4. Contestant's age shall not be less than sixteen (16) nor more than twenty-six (26) years of age on September 1st of the year of competition.
5. Contestant must be of partial Czech, Moravian, or Slovak descent.
6. Contestant agrees to provide her own costume (kroj) for the Nebraska Czech-Slovak Queen Pageant if selected as the York Chapter Queen. The costume must be authentic to the region of her ancestry. It may be her own creation or locally made. Imported costumes are not acceptable.
7. The talent act is limited to not more than three (3) minutes. The contestant must display in that period of time, a talent presentation which must be live. This talent may be singing, dancing, playing a musical instrument, giving a dramatic reading, gymnastics, art display, dress designing, creative poetry, etc., or she may give a three minute talk on a subject of her choosing. Partners are not permitted. However, accompanists and tapes are accepted.
8. Entries must be received by the Queen Coordinator no later than March 13, 2020. Send completed entry forms to: Pam Hromadka-Ernst at ph64017@gmail.com or to her mailing address at 760 County Road 300, Friend, NE 68359. Questions may be directed to Pam at 402-366-1132 or to her email address.
9. The winner will be crowned as queen for the Nebraska Czechs of York. She will receive a cash gift and other awards. She will represent the York area in the Nebraska Czech-Slovak Queen Pageant the fourth weekend in June in Clarkson, NE.

KROJ DESCRIPTION

When writing a kroj narration, you are asked to use third person rather than first person when describing your kroj. (Example: Mary Smith of the York Chapter is wearing a blue skirt with red trim.....She is wearing her grandmother's garnet earrings and bracelet.....).
